TJ Bands Fundraising Credit Policy

Students will receive \$0.50 credit for each item sold for the first 25 merchandise items sold.

After the first 25 items, students will receive \$1.00 credit for each merchandise item sold.

Merchandise items include citrus, pies, desserts, license plate frames, White House holiday ornaments, and spirit wear. For citrus sales, each separate full box or half box will count as one item.

Students may receive this credit for delivering items that are ordered directly through the adult in charge of a fundraising activity. For example, some loyal citrus customers place their orders directly with our parent in charge of citrus but request that the citrus be delivered to their house (rather than picking it up at TJ). A TJ student who delivers those orders can receive the credit described in this policy. Only one student may receive credit for any single item (i.e., for any single item, we cannot give a credit to one student for selling the item and a credit to another student for delivering that same item—if a student takes credit for selling the item, he/she would also be responsible for delivering the item if the purchaser requests delivery).
